

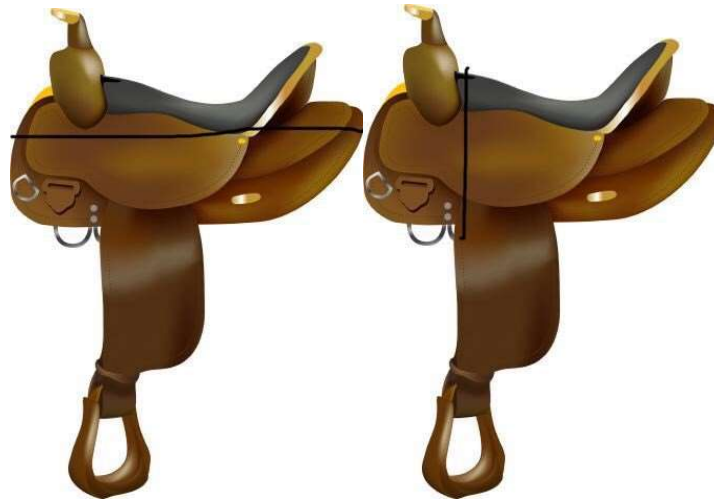

Saddle Pad Measure

Western Saddle

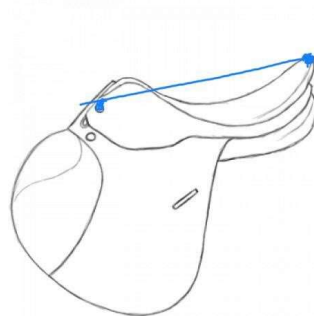
Drop is determined from the center of the saddle from the underneath, to the bottom of the cinch rings, or rigging.

Seat is measured along the top under the swells and cantle from the longest points. Add 3 inches minimum, or max of 4 inches to this measurement to determine the back length.



English Saddle

Then English pad measurement is decided by seat size. Measure from the nailhead in the front of the saddle, and in a taught line to the center of the cantle. Standard is 17-17.5, a medium is 18-18.5, and a large is 19-19.5 seat. Standard protection up to 190 lbs. Extra protection is 190 to 300 lbs.
